Cal State Fullerton has been growing since 1957; it was founded by an Act of the California Legislature. In Fall 1959, classes began in facilities leased from the Fullerton Union High School District. Those facilities were located on 225 acres of Orange County's first Valencia orange groves.

By 1960, classes were held in a permanent site. As the university and its campus grew, orange groves slowly disappeared. In their place now stands a comprehensive, regional university that grows minds, ideas, a community, a local economy — and produces graduates with a global outlook, who blossom into dominant players in the region's intellectual, cultural, and business development.

In Spring of 1962, several enterprising students established an Elephant Racing Club, and invited 100 universities to enter "The First Intercollegiate Elephant Race In Human History." Spectators, camera-crews in helicopters, all watched 15 towering pachyderms lumber to the finish line of "Dumbo Downs." The competition attracted worldwide news coverage: Associated Press ranked CSUF's tall elephant story as one of the year's top ten.

Our big elephant story is only one of many stories — big, funny, and important — we can look back on with nostalgia and pride as we celebrate forty years of excellence. We have a future of big stories waiting ahead of us.

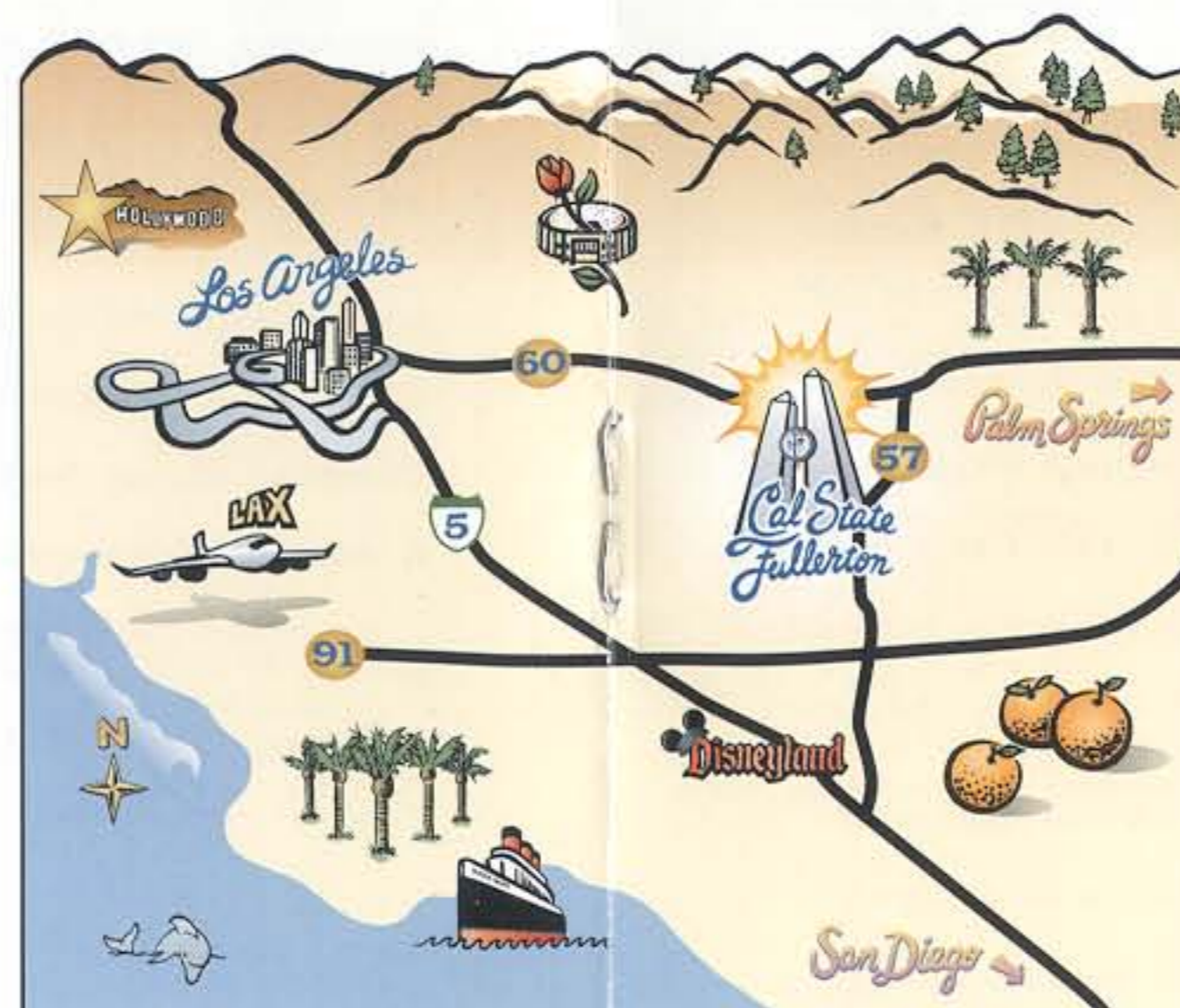

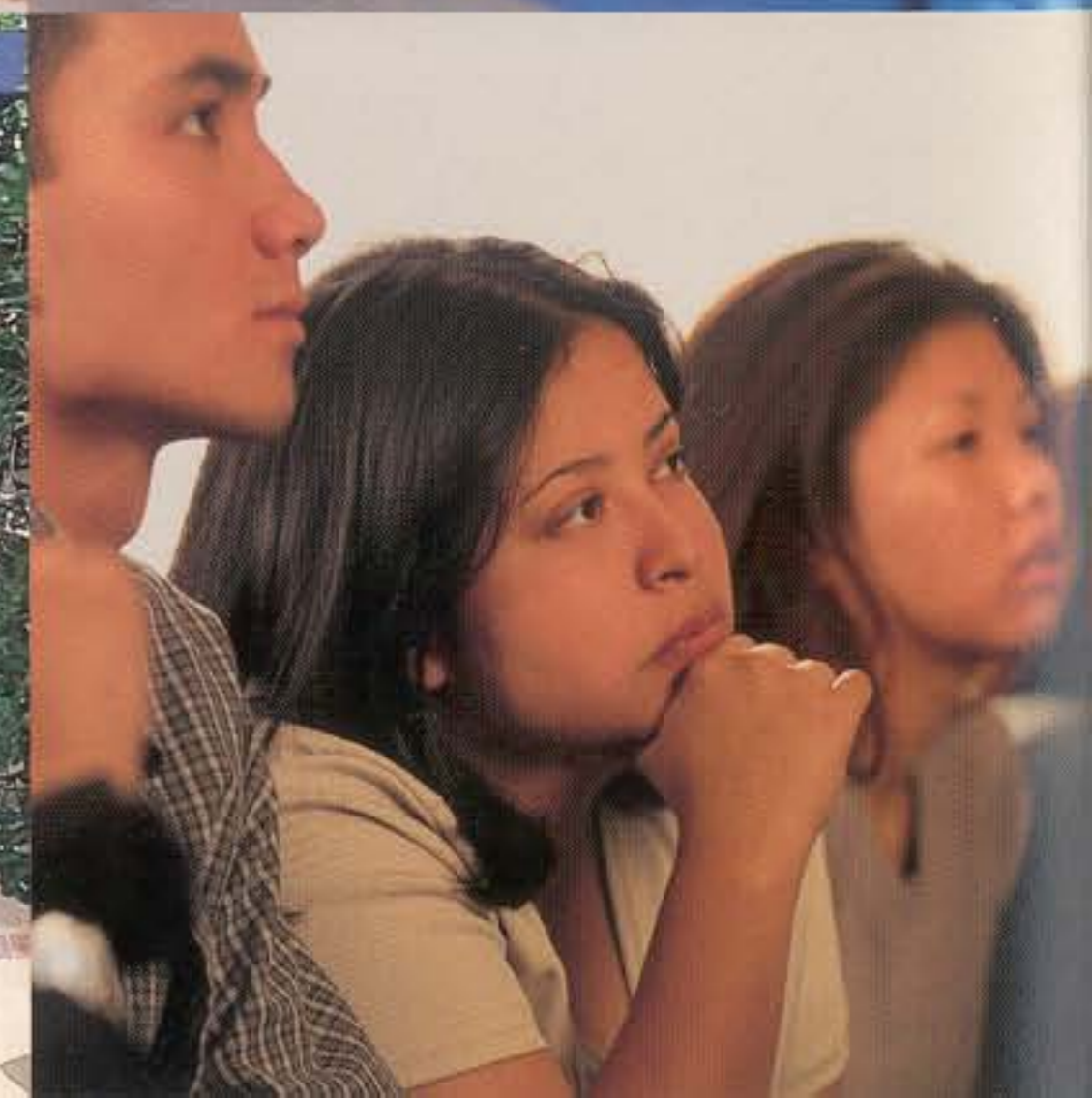
